CURATOR LED TOUR OF THE CHINESE GALLERY AT ACM FOR SEACS MEMBERS

SEACS members have a unique opportunity to join a curator led tour of the Chinese Gallery in Level 3 (Kwek Hong Png wing) which was opened to the public this year. Join Conan Cheong, Curator ACM, for a guided tour of the gallery that houses objects made for ritual burial in tombs to wares destined for the emperor's dining table. The objects inspire stories of how they were made, used, traded, and valued in the history of China. In addition, we will also have an opportunity to view one of the finest collections of Dehua wares, the creamy white porcelains made in the Dehua kilns in Fujian province, which were highly coveted by Europeans and others outside China.
