Adventures in Yuan Blue and White

Please join us for a talk on a fascinating topic:

Yuan Dynasty (1279-1368) blue and white porcelain is one of the most artistically important types of Chinese porcelain. Sent abroad on the Silk Road and the Maritime Silk Route, Yuan blue and white was traded throughout Southeast Asia, the Indian Ocean, the Middle East, and East Africa. It was an immediate success, and made Jingdezhen, its source, the Porcelain Capital of the World.

Despite its fame today, the very existence of Yuan blue and white was forgotten for almost 600 years. There is still much about it that we do not know.

Mr. Gaskin will discuss the rediscovery of Yuan blue and white porcelain in the 20th century; the importance of shards from Trowulan, Java; and his efforts to restore and exhibit the largest collection of Yuan blue and white in the world, located in Delhi, India.

Steve Gaskin is a collector and student of Yuan blue and white porcelain and recently donated his collection of Yuan blue and white porcelain shards to the Palace Museum in Beijing.
